COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is for either beginners or intermediate learners to help develop photography skills and/or focus on specific photographic projects. You will initially be taken through the key stages in photography, working with composition, exposure and image editing. The tutor will support you on a variety of subject areas including portraiture, landscape, architecture, travel and street photography. You will learn all the basics and some more advanced skills including digital imaging and darkroom processing.

By the end of the course, you should be familiar and competent through practise in the following topics:

- Understanding the importance of composition and working with exposure in photography
- Familiarity with automatic and manual settings on a range of cameras
- Experiment with shutter speed, spot-focus, depth-of-field and ISO
- Darkroom film processing and digital image editing
- Presentation techniques for image sequencing
- Photobook publication and working with narrative

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

Any camera, memory card and a USB memory stick for saving your work for future use.
