PRIOR KNOWLEDGE/SKILLS REQUIRED:

GCSE English and Maths at grade 9 – 4 (A* - C) and at least one of the following:

1. A full level 2 qualification or five GCSE's 9 – 4 (A*-C)
2. Substantial work experience in a related field (to be discussed at interview).

N.B if you do not have GCSE Maths at grade A*-C (9-4), you will still be considered for the programme and this will be discussed at interview. You are strongly encouraged to re-sit this qualification. There are opportunities to study adult GCSE courses at the College, but this will require a separate application.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course will provide specialist knowledge, skills and understanding relating to working in the police service in areas such as leadership skills, physical fitness, equality and diversity and inclusion, which can be applied to current or future employment. The course content has been developed with employers, subject experts and tutors to ensure that it's relevant to the real world and meets the needs of employers.

The course is continuously assessed through assignments, practical project tasks and case studies. It uses practical activities, presentations and involvement with local Public Services wherever possible.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

- Prepare for a career in the police service
- The influence of UK government, international organisations and the media on the police service
- Understand the impact of war and conflict on the police service

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

This qualification is internally assessed with a Portfolio of Evidence.

UCAS points have been awarded for this qualification as follows: D* = 28, D = 24, M = 16, P = 8

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

- You may need to purchase uniform items consisting of trousers, polo shirts, sweat tops, a waterproof jacket and black boots. Uniform can be purchased during enrolment
- You will need pens and paper and relevant stationery to complete basic classroom tasks.

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

The main outcome of this qualification is progression to employment as it helps you develop knowledge, understanding and skills required to apply for entry to the police service. It can also support you in further study. There is a wide range of job roles available in the police service. After a probationary period, you could explore areas such as the Fraud Squad, dog handling, child protection or fire arms. It offers a lot of opportunities for career progression.
