

### DURATION, DAY, DATE AND TIME OF THE COURSE:

34 weeks starting from Tuesday 14 September 2021, 18:00 – 21:00.

### VENUE AND DURATION OF COURSE:

This course combines online learning with face-to-face lessons in the classroom at East Surrey College, Gatton Point, London Road, Redhill RH1 2JX.

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

There are no formal requirements for this course; however, it is preferred that you have a minimum Level 4/5 qualification in your own area of specialism and hold a Level 2 qualification in English and Maths. Candidates must be considering a subject for delivery and be aiming to achieve / or have achieved a qualification and/or have experience in their subject/skill at the appropriate level. Candidates also have to produce evidence of being able to deliver at least 100 hours of teaching.

### WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

Once you have completed the DET, this will enable you to gain QTLS - Qualified Teacher Learning and Skills status with the Society for Learning/Education and Training Foundation, the professional body for further education and teaching qualifications.

### COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The Diploma in Education and Training (DET) is the ultimate qualification for teaching or training. It has been developed in conjunction with Ofqual, and is recognised by the Society for Education and Training. The Diploma in Education and Training is a recognised route to gaining Qualified Teacher Learning and Skills (QTLS) status, enabling you to teach in schools, colleges and in further education. This course will be taught through a combination of traditional classroom-based lessons and online sessions.

This course will enable you to take a practical and analytical approach to all the aspects of training and education, right from planning and designing learning through to teaching, assessing and supporting learners. You will also cover the theories and principles of education and training and be given the opportunity to embed these in your own teaching and practice.

**Delivery model: 1 week in the classroom, 1 week remote delivery via Teams.**

### UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

- Teaching, learning and assessment in education and training
- Developing teaching learning and assessment in education and training
- Theories, principles and models of education and training
- Wider professional practice and development in education and training

## TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

To achieve the Level 5 Diploma in Education and Training, candidates must achieve a minimum of 120 credits, mandatory and optional units. There is a mix of theoretical and practical assignments: 7 written assignments and 8 observations of teaching.

## WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

These qualifications can help you to progress in teaching/training in a wide range of organisations in the lifelong learning. These include:

- Public sector organisations
- Private sector organisations
- Further Education, Adult and Community Education.

The course content is exactly the same as a PGCE (Post-Graduate Certificate in Education) in Lifelong Learning and carries the same value and credit with regulators, employers and the education and training sectors. Once you have completed the DET, this will enable you to gain QTLS - Qualified Teacher Learning and Skills status with the Society for Learning/Education and Training Foundation, the professional body for further education and teaching qualifications.

The qualification also allows candidates to progress to the following City & Guilds qualifications:

- Professional recognition qualifications
- Level 5 Diplomas in specialist teaching
