

DURATION, DAY, DATE AND TIME OF THE COURSE:

22 weeks starting from Thursday 6 January 2022, 17:30 - 20:30.

VENUE:

This course combines online learning with face-to-face lessons in the classroom at East Surrey College, Gatton Point, London Road, Redhill RH1 2JX.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

There are no formal requirements for this course; however, it is preferred that you have a minimum Level 3 qualification in your own area of specialism and hold a Level 2 qualification in English and Maths. Candidates must be considering a subject for delivery and be aiming to achieve / or have achieved a qualification and/or have experience in their subject/skill at the appropriate level.

Candidates have to produce evidence of being able to deliver at least 30 hours of teaching.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

Level 4 Certificate in Education and Training.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course will be taught through a combination of traditional classroom-based lessons and online sessions. The Level 4 Certificate in Education and Training is a first stage teaching qualification, which has a teaching/training practice requirement. It is an 'in service' qualification designed for those working or wishing to work as teachers/trainers in England. It may be possible for pre-service teachers/trainers (defined as those who are not formally contracted as teachers/trainers) to also complete this qualification. This qualification is also suitable for those delivering education and training in any learning environment.

Delivery model: 1 week in the classroom, 1 week remote delivery via Teams.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

- Understanding roles, responsibilities and relationships in education and training
- Planning to meet the needs of learners in education and training
- Delivering education and training
- Assessing learners in education and training
- Using resources for education and training

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

To achieve the Level 4 Certificate in Education and Training, candidates must achieve a minimum of 36 credits, mandatory and optional units. There is a mix of theoretical and practical assignments: 6 written assignments and 3 observations of teaching.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

Lever Arch File and basic stationery.

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

The qualification allows candidates to progress into employment as teachers/trainers, as well as to the following City & Guilds qualifications:

- Level 5 Diploma in Education and Training

These qualifications can also help you to progress in teaching/training in a wide range of organisations in the lifelong learning sector. These include:

- Public sector organisations
- Private sector organisations
- Further Education, Adult and Community Education
