PRIOR KNOWLEDGE/SKILLS REQUIRED:

There are no entry requirements for this course.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Learners will develop an individual painting as part of a themed group project. Past themes have included birds, trees, and landscape. Styles may include abstract, figurative and experimental. Careful support and tuition will enable learners to develop an idea from sketch to canvas in oil or acrylic. One to one tuition and group tutorial will enable lively discussion.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

Equipment needed at the first session is, at the very least, some drawing pencils, an eraser and paper. Learners will provide their own materials for further work and Veronica will advise you if you are unsure of equipment or colour ranges. Plus materials supplied by learner so they can complete the course. Please expect to be asked to buy good quality materials for each class including pencils, paper, paints, canvases and brushes.

If you know how to stretch paper, please come with two pieces stretched onto a lightweight drawing board. If not, please just wait for instructions, but you will still need a drawing board. You will be asked to purchase other items as we go on, including masking fluid.
