PRIOR KNOWLEDGE/SKILLS REQUIRED:

None

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

An appropriate level of literacy is required and an interview is necessary. Candidates will need to be able to practice at home and provide clients for assessment at the ESC Escape Salon. Willingness to follow uniform guidelines and comply with College attendance and punctuality expectations are also essential.

Please note that this is an intensive course and will require great commitment to complete. There will be a lot of research and assignments to be completed independently and a high level of attendance will be required in order to achieve.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

Level 2 Certificate in Women's Hairdressing

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This is an intermediate vocational qualification that focuses on the development of a broad range of women's hairdressing skills, supported by relevant underpinning theoretical knowledge. The purpose of this qualification is to develop a high level of occupational ability and provide a sound platform from which to progress to a Level 2 NVQ or Diploma in hairdressing.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

- Follow Health and Safety practice in the salon
- Working in the hair industry
- Cut women's hair
- The Art of dressing hair
- Shampoo and condition the hair and scalp
- Client consultation for hair services
- Colour and lighten hair

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

A portfolio of practical work, exams and assignments

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

- East Surrey College uniform is required: plain black clothing, smart black clothes, and black leather shoes.
- Specific equipment kit required (approximately £170).

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

Students who successfully complete this qualification will have the opportunity to progress to a Level 3 qualification or an Apprenticeship. This qualification may also lead directly into supervised employment.

COURSE FEE:

£823 Standard Fee / £1,645 Full Fee

If you are 19+ on 31 August 2022 and meet the ESFA (Education & Skills Funding Agency) residency criteria, the standard fee will apply unless you qualify for free tuition.

The full fee will apply if you are aged 19+ on 31 August 2022 and you do not meet the ESFA residency criteria or if there is no Government funding for this qualification.
