

VENUE AND DURATION OF COURSE:

East Surrey College, Gatton Point, Redhill, RH1 2JX, 1 Year, Full-time.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

You need to be either working in the industry and/or have good practical skills. Successful completion of Level 2 Hairdressing and GCSEs grade 9-4 (A*-C) in English and Maths. A positive reference from your tutor and a good attendance record. You will need to be able to practice at home and provide your own models to be clients for assessment at the East Surrey College Salon, Escape.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

Level 3 Diploma in Hairdressing.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

You will update and extend your hairdressing skills gained at Level 2 to include advanced colouring techniques and high fashion work. You will take part in fashion shows and competitions to help develop your career to become a top flight stylist or trainer. You will also be expected to participate in relevant work experience, if not already employed in a salon.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

- Monitor procedures to safely control work operations
- Promote additional products or services to clients
- Provide hairdressing consultation services
- Creatively cut hair using a combination of techniques
- Colour hair using a variety of techniques
- Provide colour correction services
- Creatively style and dress hair
- Creatively dress long hair
- Develop and enhance your creative hairdressing skills
- Create a variety of permed effects
- Provide creative hair extension services (additional cost of approximately £250)

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

A portfolio of practical work, exams and assignments.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

- East Surrey College uniform is required - £50.00 approximately
- A specific kit of equipment is required - £172.00 approximately

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

You will have the chance to progress into employment working in a salon or continue to develop your skills on a Higher Apprenticeship, Higher Education course at ESC or an undergraduate Degree at University.

COURSE FEE:

If you are under 19 on 31 August 2022, tuition is free. If you are 19 or over, please consult Client Services for advice and guidance on funding and eligibility.

Please be aware that there may be additional costs for equipment and educational visits. This information will be available from the curriculum staff at interview.
