

VENUE AND DURATION OF COURSE:

East Surrey College, Gatton Point, Redhill, RH1 2JX, 1 year full-time.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Few formal qualifications, ideally 4 GCSEs grade 9-1 (A*-G) that includes English & Maths.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

Basic Construction Skills Level 1 Diploma.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is an ideal introduction to the construction industry and covers the essential skills within the following construction trades: site carpentry, bricklaying, plumbing, tiling and plastering. Through learning the skills and knowledge needed for a variety of trades, you will understand how they interact and work with one another.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

- Safe working practices in construction/health & safety
- Knowledge of information, quantities and communicating with others
- Building methods and construction technology
- Small scale masonry trade repairs/brickwork
- Small scale painting, decorating and associated trade repairs
- Wood trade repairs

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

Online tests and a portfolio of evidence.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

All students will be required to wear college uniform. Steel toe capped boots must be worn at all time when in the workshops.

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

On successful completion of this course you may progress onto either Maintenance Operations Level 2 Diploma or a Level 1 Diploma in a trade specific discipline.

COURSE FEE:

If you are under 19 on 31/08/2022, tuition is free. If you are 19 or over, please consult Client Services for advice and guidance on funding and eligibility.

You will need to purchase uniform items such as a polo shirt, trousers and other personal protection equipment (PPE). Please be aware that there may be additional costs for equipment and educational visits. This information will be available from the curriculum staff at interview.
