

VENUE AND DURATION OF COURSE:

East Surrey College, Gatton Point, London Road, Redhill, RH1 2JX, 1 year, Full-time.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- 5 GCSEs grade A*-D (9-3) including English & Maths and an interview, or a Level 1 in Hairdressing or Beauty and GCSE A-D (9-3) in Maths and English.
- A positive reference from your tutor and a proven track record of good attendance and punctuality.
- Willingness to follow uniform guidelines and comply with college attendance and punctuality standards is essential.
- Candidates will also need to be able to practise at home and provide clients for assessment at the East Surrey College salons.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

- Level 2 Diploma in Hair & Media Make-Up Studies
- GCSEs in English or Maths (for those who have not achieved Grade C or above)

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The VTCT Level 2 Diploma in Hair & Media Make-Up Studies (QCF) is a qualification that will develop your practical skills in a broad range of hair styling skills and media make-up.

Underpinning this qualification, you will develop a sound knowledge and understanding of the theory for each unit and gain the skills needed to progress to further training to become a successful hairdresser or make-up artist.

You will also be expected to participate in relevant work experience

- Following Health and Safety Practices in the Salon
- The Art of Photographic Make-up
- The Art of Dressing Hair
- Applying Make-up
- Create an Image Based on a Theme within the Hair and Beauty Sector
- Body Art
- Face Painting

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

A portfolio of practical work, exams and assignments.

- Uniform – All black, smart top and trousers, black leather shoes
