Level 1 Diploma in an Introduction to the Travel and Tourism Industry

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This qualification meets the needs of candidates who wish to work as a Holiday Representative, Tour Guide, Tourist Information Centre Assistant or Travel Agent in the Travel and Tourism sector. It allows you to gain introductory knowledge and understanding of the industry. It allows students to enter employment in the industry or progress onto higher-level Travel courses.

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

- Coursework (written assignment tasks)
- Short tests
- Role-plays and observations
- Computer-based exams (externally set)
- A Portfolio of evidence and coursework is required
