### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

### WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

City and Guilds Wood Occupations Level 1 Diploma.

### COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course teaches you the skills required for a trainee carpenter and joiner. You will learn the basic joints used in carpentry and joinery as well as site health and safety and how to store resources.

### UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

- Practical hand skills/safe use of power hand tools
- Site carpentry or bench joinery orientated subjects
- City & Guilds units are:
  - Health and Safety
  - Principles of Construction
  - Carpentry Hand Tools
  - Portable Power Tools
  - Woodworking joints

### TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

Online tests and a portfolio of evidence.

### EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

- Pens, pencils and a course textbook (Full list to be provided by tutor)

Steel toe capped boots and work trousers must be worn at all time when in the workshops.

### WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

Level 2 Diploma in Site Carpentry or Bench Joinery, or an Apprenticeship.
