East Surrey College, Gatton Point, London Road, Redhill RH1 2JX, 1 year Full-time.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Vehicle Maintenance Level 1 Diploma or equivalent.

## WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

Vehicle Maintenance & Repair City & Guilds Level 2 Certificate.

## COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The Level 2 Certificate enables you to further your career opportunities as a vehicle fitter, or lead you on to an Apprenticeship as a vehicle maintenance technician; you will extend your learning of vehicle repair through a mixture of practical and theoretical tasks in our newly built and highly equipped Motor Vehicle workshop and classrooms.

## UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

The qualification includes the following areas:

- Health, Safety and Good Housekeeping
- Materials and Fabrication & Tools
- Light Vehicle Engine components
- Light Vehicle Fuel & Ignition
- Light Vehicle Suspension
- Light Vehicle Steering
- Light Vehicle Braking Systems
- Light Vehicle Servicing

## TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

All work is continually assessed by observation of practical tasks as well as written tests and end of unit online examinations. A portfolio will need to be completed by the candidate for submission at the end of the course.

## EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

All students will be required to wear College uniform. Steel toe capped boots must be worn at all time when in the workshops. Students will also need to bring in stationery equipment such as pens, pencils, calculator, lever arch folder and recommended textbooks.

## WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

A successful student within this course may have the opportunity to study a Level 2 Diploma in Vehicle Maintenance or go onto employment as an Apprentice within the motor trade.

## COURSE FEE:

If you are under 19 on 31/08/2022, tuition is free. If you are 19 or over, please consult Client Services for advice and guidance on funding and eligibility.
