

Multiply: Maths with ESOL is a course available to ESOL and EFL students who would like to achieve a UK Maths Qualification. This Maths course provides Intensive delivery of Functional Skills qualifications at Level 2. The content is aimed at ESOL learners as it has a focus on overcoming language barriers. This course will also develop student confidence in using Maths skills in their day to day lives.

VENUE AND DURATION OF COURSE:

3hrs per week: 16 weeks online delivery (Tuesday 9:30 – 12:30)

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

None

Week 1 will include an initial assessment to identify skills and existing knowledge of Maths.

WILL I GAIN ANY QUALIFICATIONS?

You will take a Functional Skills Maths exam at the end of the course. The level of qualification will be based on individual skills and abilities.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Multiply: Maths in ESOL is a course available to students aged 19+, who have English as a second/foreign language and are interested in gaining a Maths qualification. It provides study based on topics commonly assessed in Functional Skills qualifications with ESOL language, vocabulary and comprehension skills embedded within the course delivery.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

1. Using Number: BIDMAS, Core Number Skills, Fractions, Decimals, Percentages, Ratio & Proportion
2. Common Measures: Units of measure, Conversions, Area, Perimeter, Volume, Density, Scale drawings, Plans & Elevations
3. Handling Data: Mean, Median, Mode, Range, Probability, Graphs and Charts

ASSESSMENT:

Paper based Exam: Paper 1 Non-calculator & Paper 2 Calculator

- Calculator
