

## START DATE & DURATION:

The qualification start date is flexible and should be completed within 18 months.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

There are no entry requirements for this qualification. Anyone over the age of 19 that is seeking to demonstrate competence in working in brick occupations can take this qualification. However, it is preferable that you hold the Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Trowel Occupations (Construction), or have significant experience working with brick within the construction industry, along with the appropriate English and Maths.

## WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

Trowel Occupations (Construction) Level 3 NVQ Diploma

## QUALIFICATION OVERVIEW:

This is a work-based learning qualification for those who are already employed as a bricklayer in the construction sector. It allows you to learn, develop and practise the skills required for employment and/or career progression in bricklaying. It covers areas such as working on a construction site, setting out structures and carrying out complex building work.

## UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

To achieve this qualification a minimum of 150 credits need to be attained. This comprises the 8 mandatory units plus 1 unit from the optional unit group.

### Mandatory units:

1. Setting Out Masonry Structures in the Workplace
2. Setting Out Complex Masonry Structures in the Workplace
3. Erecting Masonry Structures in the Workplace
4. Erecting Complex Masonry Structures in the Workplace
5. Developing and Maintaining Good Occupational Working Relationships in the Workplace
6. Conforming to General Health, Safety and Welfare in the Workplace
7. Confirming Work Activities and Resources for an Occupational Work Area in the Workplace
8. Confirming the Occupational Method of Work in the Workplace

### Optional units:

1. Repairing and Maintaining Masonry Structures in the Workplace
2. Producing internal solid plastering finishes in the Workplace
3. Placing and Finishing Non-Specialist Concrete in the Workplace
4. Maintaining Slate and Tile Roofing in the Workplace
5. Installing Drainage in the Workplace
6. Erecting thin joint masonry structures in the Workplace
7. Erecting Masonry Cladding in the Workplace
8. Applying solid render to background surfaces and producing finishes in the Workplace

## TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

You will be assessed on your Portfolio of Evidence that is gathered in the workplace.

## WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

This qualification prepares you for work in the construction industry, with a specific focus on brick occupations. Upon completion you can apply to CSCS, or other industry card schemes, to gain a recognised skills card. If you wish to progress further in construction, you may wish to study any of the following qualifications:

- Construction Site Supervision (Construction) Level 4 Diploma NVQ
- Construction Site Management (Construction) Level 6 Diploma NVQ
