

# Education and Training (CET) Level 4 Certificate Course Code – METP1415XA

# **DURATION, DAY, DATE AND TIME OF THE COURSE:**

This is a part-time programme lasting for 22 weeks starting from Thursday 18 January 2024, 17:30 – 20:30.



#### VENUE:

This course is offered at East Surrey College and combines face-to-face lessons in the classroom, remote delivery via Teams, and one-to-one tutorials.

## **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:**

There are no formal requirements for this course, however, it is preferred that you have a minimum level 3 qualification in your own area of specialism and hold al level 2 qualification in English and maths. Candidates must be considering a subject for delivery and be aiming to achieve/or have achieved a qualification and/or have experience in their subject/skill at the appropriate level.

Candidates have to produce evidence of being able to deliver at least 30 hours of teaching.

## WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

On successful completion of this course students will achieve a Certificate in Education and Training (CET) Level 4 qualification.

## **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

The Certificate in Education and Training (CET) Level 4 is a first stage teaching qualification, which has a teaching/training practice requirement. It is an 'in service' qualification for those working or wishing to work as teachers/trainers in England.

It may be possible for pre-service teachers/trainers (defined as those who are not formally contracted as teachers/trainers) to also complete this qualification. This qualification is also suitable for those delivering education and training in any learning environment.

# **DELIVERY MODEL:**

A combination of face-to-face lessons in the classroom, remote delivery via Teams, one-to-one tutorials.

## **UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:**

- · Understanding roles, responsibilities and relationships in education and training
- Planning to meet the needs of learners in education and training
- Delivering education and training
- Assessing learners in education and training
- · Using resources for education and training
- · Managing behaviours in a learning environment
- Working with the 14-19 age range

# **TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:**

To achieve the Certificate in Education and Training (CET) Level 4 qualification, candidates must achieve a minimum of 36 credits, mandatory and optional units. There is a mix of theoretical and practical assignments: six written assignments and three observations of teaching.









#### **EQUIPMENT NEEDED:**

Lever arch file and basic stationery.

The qualification allows candidates to progress into employment as teachers/trainers, as well as to the following City & Guilds qualifications:
