VENUE AND DURATION OF COURSE:

East Surrey College, Gatton Point, London Road, Redhill, RH1 2JX, 1 year Full-time, 3 days per week (Some English or Maths sessions may be in addition to these days).

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

4 GCSE grades 9-2 (A*-E) that include English & Maths.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

- Creative Media UAL Level 1 Diploma
- Functional Skills in English and Maths or GCSE retakes for students with GCSE grade 3 (D).

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The Level 1 Diploma is designed to develop your creative skills needed for this subject and encourage achievement to your full potential. The course offers a broad introduction to Creative Media for those with little practical experience, but who are committed to working in this area. This is a good access course for the subject in order to prepare learners for Level 2 or as a stepping-stone to alternative courses or employment.

Work may include:

- Moving Image
- Sound and music
- Games design
- Photography
- Animation and Video

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

This course offers a wide range of exploration using different media, resources, and processes. Units and topics include:

- Introduction to materials, processes and skills
- Introduction to contextual research
- Introduction to communication skills
- Solving 2D creative problems
- Solving 3D creative problems
- · Solving time-based creative problems

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

At the end of each unit, there is a formal assessment by portfolio and tutorial.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

You may need to buy some materials if you choose to work with resources, which are not provided. A list of materials will be given on the first day of term.









WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

This course provides the progression route for a career in the creative industries and can offer the chance to progress on to the Art, Design and Media UAL Level 2 Diploma or the Creative Media UAL Level 2 Diploma.
