WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

Brickwork Level 1 City & Guilds Diploma.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Based in our fully-equipped workshops, this course covers the theory and practice of Bricklaying in a realistic environment. Learn how to build structures, handle and store resources, work as part of a team, prepare bricklaying materials and components as well as health & safety on site.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

- Health, safety and welfare in construction and associated industries
- Knowledge of technical information, quantities and communication with others
- Knowledge of construction technology
- Setting out for basic masonry structures
- · Mix construction materials
- Construct block, brick and cavity walling

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

Online tests and a portfolio of evidence.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

Pens, pencils and a notepad

To meet health and safety requirements within our realistic work environment, all students will be required to wear college uniform. Steel toe capped boots must be worn at all time when in the workshops.

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

Bricklaying Level 2 Diploma. It can also be used as a progression route to achieving an NVQ or Apprenticeship in Bricklaying.

COURSE FEE:

If you are under 19 on 31/08/2024, tuition is free. If you are 19 or over, please consult Client Services for advice and guidance on funding and eligibility.
