

DURATION, DAY, DATE AND TIME OF THE COURSE:

Running for 10 weeks starting Thursday 19 September 2024, 18:30-20:30

PRIOR KNOWLEDGE/SKILLS REQUIRED:

There are no entry requirements for this course. Although an appreciation for Fine Art & Photography is desirable.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is for either beginners or intermediate students to help develop photography skills and/or focus on specific photographic projects. You will initially be taken through creative and analogue key stages in photography, working with composition, exposure and image editing. The tutor will support you on a variety of printing processes and practices including cyanotype, cyanolumen, lumen photography, phytograms, chemigrams and rayograms. You will learn all the basics and some more advanced skills including digital image manipulation and analogue darkroom printing.

By the end of the course, you should be familiar and competent through practice in the following topics:

- Understanding the importance of composition, texture, and colour
- Familiarity with alternative and analogue darkroom processes
- Experiment with shutter speed, aperture, papers, and ISO
- Familiarity with digital enhancement and editing software
- Analogue darkroom chemistry
- Presentation techniques and working with narrative
- Portfolio building for image sequencing

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

Any camera, memory card and a USB memory stick for saving your work for future use. Smartphone to access IT system.
