ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

4 GCSEs grades 9-3 (A*-D), that include Art or Design Technology, English or Maths or; BTEC Level 1 and GCSE grade 9-3 (A*-D) in English and Maths. It would be desirable to have GCSE grade 9-4 (A*-C) in English or Maths for this course.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

Music Production Level 2 Diploma

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The Level 2 Diploma in Music Performance and Production has been developed to provide students with an understanding of music performance and production as a collaborative activity and prepare them for the reality of the sector, progression and paths available to them.

The qualification has been designed for students who have an interest in music performance and/or music production, or a related subject, who wish to explore and extend this interest via a Full-time, immersive learning experience.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

There are four industry-based projects in a year that include the following topics: An Introduction to Music Performance and Production, Listening Skills, Composition, Research, Music Production and Performance skills and the Major Project.

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

Assessment is continuous and via submitted coursework. At the end of each project there is a formal assessment and tutorial.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

Headphones and a 500GB (or larger) USB storage device are both essential.

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

Students who complete a UAL Diploma in Music Performance & Production Level 2 will obtain a qualification, which will enable progression to further study, training, or employment and enable them to make informed choices with regard to a career in the music industry. They will also have developed transferable skills that may be applicable in other work situations or will enable them to progress to Level 3 qualifications in other sectors should they have the required grades.
