COURSE DESCRIPTION:

If you are interested in a career in the plumbing industry, then this is the entry course for you. You will learn the basic skills required for the industry, health and safety, and work as part of a team whilst working in a fully equipped and realistic workshop. This course is a combination of practical work and theory.

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

Paper-based tests and a portfolio of evidence.

Steel toe capped boots and work trousers must be worn at all time when in the workshops.

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

Plumbing Level 2 Diploma, NVQ or an Apprenticeship.

COURSE FEE:
