

VENUE AND DURATION OF COURSE:

East Surrey College, Gatton Point, Redhill, RH1 2JX, 1 year Full-time, 3 days per week.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

5 GCSE grades 9-3 (A* - D) (including Art or Design Technology, English & Maths or Level 1 Diploma at a Merit or Distinction grade and GCSE grade 9-3 (A* - D) in English and Maths). A portfolio of work is to be shown at interview.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

Level 2 Diploma in Art & Design.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This intermediate course is aimed at students who want to build on their experience of Art & Design from school. The course gives a broad introduction to the subject areas as well as the important basic skills and understanding needed in this subject area. It includes Painting, Graphic Design, Drawing, 3D Work, Photography, Digital Imaging and Animation. This course gives a solid foundation for a career route into a job in the Creative Industries. It also provides a progression route to the more specialist Art & Design Level 3 Extended Diploma.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

There are eight units over one year, including common units and specialist units. Mandatory work experience will also be undertaken by all students outside college hours.

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

At the end of each unit, there is a formal assessment by portfolio and tutorial.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

Pens, pencils, acrylic paints, a general equipment work box.

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

This course provides the progression route for a career in the creative industries of Art, Design and Media also the Art & Design Level 3 Extended Diploma specialising in subjects such as: Graphic Design, Fashion and Textiles, Illustration, Animation, Multimedia Design, Three Dimensional Design, Photography, Fine Art and the Film and Television Production Level 3 Diploma in if students have the required grades.
