

VENUE AND DURATION OF COURSE:

East Surrey College (Institution Number: E32), Gatton Point, Redhill, RH1 2JX. 2 years, Full-Time.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- A Levels in relevant Media or Art based subjects, or an artistic background and evidence of work in a portfolio, or progression from Art courses at Level 3
- A good range of GCSE's at Grade A-C and A2 Levels plus a recent portfolio of artwork as evidence of ability.
- You may also progress on to this course from Level 3 Diploma in Theatrical and Media Make-Up or equivalent BTEC/UAL qualification.
- In addition, you will be required to produce a positive reference
- Willingness to follow health and safety guidelines and comply with college attendance and punctuality
- Candidates will need to be able to practise at home and provide models for assessment
- Candidates who are pregnant or suffer from asthma will need to be risk assessed due to the use of hazardous chemicals.

PROGRAMME OVERVIEW:

This is for professional make-up artists and hairdressers specialising in theatrical and special effects make-up, including prosthetics and hair styling. This qualification will enable you to gain the skills, knowledge and understanding required in order to perform a range of make-up and hair services in the performance arts, fashion and media sectors. Extensive research, practise and innovation are needed to be successful in this area.

- Costume Design Concept
- Ideas in Context
- Critical Study in Art and Design
- Design Exploration for Make-Up in Performing Arts
- Design Techniques and Applications for the Performer
- Design for the Performing Arts

PROFESSIONAL RECOGNITION:

Art & Design Edexcel Higher Diploma.

ASSESSMENT:

At the end of each unit there is a formal assessment and tutorial.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

A specific kit of equipment is required - approximately £1,500

A specialised brush kit will need to be purchased at the beginning of the year - approximately £85

Purchase of photographs for portfolio - approximately £250

TUITION FEE:

£6,165 per year in 2019/20. Please be aware that there may be additional costs for equipment and educational visits. This information will be available from the curriculum staff at interview.

STUDENT LOANS AND FINANCIAL SUPPORT:

Full-time and Part-time students from the UK/EU who are studying for a Higher Education course can apply to the Student Loans Company (www.slc.co.uk) for a Tuition Fee Loan for the full amount (this will be paid directly to the College). Additionally, Full-time UK only students can apply for a Maintenance loan (to cover living costs). Part-time students are also eligible for a Maintenance Loan if they are studying an Undergraduate/Initial Teacher Training (ITT) course or a Postgraduate Certificate of Education (PGCE).

Evidence of an approved loan must be provided at enrolment in the form of the Payment Advice letter provided by the Student Loans Company. Further details of how to apply for a Student Loan can be found at www.direct.gov.uk/studentfinance.
