

Introduction to College Life

- 'Freedom' in comparison to a school environment- uniform, no bells, unstructured time
- Wide variety of vocational courses and a well resourced campus including workshops, salons, recording studios, darkrooms, gym, sports hall
- Diverse environment- College community incudes adults, apprentices, HE students, 14-16 year olds
- Timetable- 3 full days a week (excluding T levels)
- Expectation of Independent Learning (ALP)
- Expectation of learning/employability behaviours- PPE and Health and Safety



- All 16- 18 year olds are placed on a 'Study Programme'
- This includes a vocational 'main' qualification with a course leader- this is a key contact for parents/carers
- Maths and English if needed (for all who have not achieved grade 4/FS level 2). Those eligible for November resits will be calculated by number of points away from grade 4 and attendance
- Tutorial- 1.5 hours a week to cover PHSE and careers as well as one to ones
- Enrichment offer- Tuesday/Thursday afternoons as well as Weds for sports (football/Netball/Basketball) Social Action, volunteering, trips and visits are specific to the course



- All Study Programme students have at least 35 hours of work placement as part of their programme. Students must inform their tutors/work placement team of their placement so we can complete a risk assessment and ensure the suitability of the placement.
- T Levels and Health and Social Care students have considerably more
- Students are supported to find placements if they have not done so via our work placement coordinator team
- Many curriculum areas will have a 'block week' for work placement which will be discussed with students during induction
- The college has 3 qualified Careers Advisors who offer both group and one to one support- this is open to all active learners and anyone in the local community

- What parents can expect:
- Email from course leader in first 4 weeks to establish contact
- Details of course leader, programme manager, curriculum administrator to help answer any queries as they arise
- Access to Parent Portal so you can see some information about your young person's progress including attendance and individual targets
- 2 parents' evenings (November/February)- virtual and F2F options
- Active involvement in Support and Intervention process from stage 1
- Telephone call if student is sent home/suspended
- Immediate contact in case of any incident impacting on safety/wellbeing of your young person
- Please use the website for updates on college closures due to adverse weather or other reasons, term dates and upcoming college events
- GDPR for over 18s- as soon as your young person turns 18, we must ask for permission to communicate with parents and this may be refused
