Beauty Therapy and Media Make-Up

Welcome to the Beauty Therapy department!

We offer the following courses for direct entry from school depending on your level and GCSE grades:

- Level 1 Beauty Therapy
- Level 2 Beauty Therapy
- Level 2 Hair and Media Make-Up

The courses involve a wide variety of real-life scenarios and industry relevant knowledge. They are work-focused courses, which develops the necessary skills, knowledge and understanding to provide a sound, basic training for progression to Level 3. Most employers will require a Beauty Therapist to be Level 3 qualified. For the media make-up industry, you will need a Level 3 qualification and higher to be a make-up artist in theatre, film and TV. However, Level 2 Hair & Media Make-Up can be a route to working in make-up retail.

We have Level 3 Make-Up courses in Special Effects or Fashion Make-Up and courses at Higher Education Level 4 and 5 to progress to in Theatrical Make-Up.

The courses are continuously assessed through assignments, practical assessment and exams. You will learn across a vast range of different aspects of the industry including health and safety, client consultation, and, for Beauty - facial treatments, eye treatments, hair removal, manicure and massage. For Hair and Media Make-Up – day and evening make-up, period looks, hair styling, and fantasy make-up.

As well as fully-equipped College salons, you will have access to interactive online resources to support learning, include the College e-learning platform E-Zone and PivotPoint (see YouTube link for the introductory video - https://youtu.be/K6jzee_YrVg)
