- Level 2 Travel & Tourism
- Level 3 Travel & Tourism

### **Level 2 Travel & Tourism**

You will gain a City & Guilds Level 2 Diploma in Travel & Tourism which will develop your skills and gain a qualification that helps you get your dream job - whether it's tour operations or roles such as resort representatives, ski chalet hosts and guiding - or get the foundations to move onto the Level 3 qualification. The qualification has been designed to meet the needs of candidates who want to work in holiday centres, tour operator companies, travel agencies, tourist information offices, tourist attractions, cruise line companies or conference events organisations

### **Level 3 Travel & Tourism**

The Pearson BTEC Level 3 National Extended Diploma in Travel & Tourism is equivalent in size to 3 A Levels and is typically a two-year full-time 16–19 study programme. It will allow you to focus your study on this sector, with a view to progression direct to employment in the travel and tourism industry, in a particular specialist area of work, such as tour operations, travel consultancy or business development. Alternatively, you may take a degree programme related to travel and tourism before taking up employment in the sector.
