Course Name - Level 3 NVQ / Diploma in Health & Social Care

Course Code - BSEP2311OA

Duration, day and time of the course:

Candidates should be able to complete the course within 9 to 12 months. Candidates are assessed in their place of work.

Entry requirements:

There are no formal entry requirements for this qualification; however learners must be employed in a supervisory caring services role.

What qualifications will I get?

Level 3 NVQ/Diploma in Health & Social Care (subject specific or generic depending on route selected)

Course description:

The Level 3 NVQ/Diploma in Health & Social Care is designed to reflect the work of candidates who provide support to service users within a range of Health and Social Care settings.

The qualification is work based and supports the candidate to develop the knowledge, skills and competencies needed to work in a supervisory role within a care environment. The award will look at all aspects of the care worker's role and its requirements, which include the following: communication, health & safety, safeguarding and personal development. Within the candidates supervisory position we would anticipate that they would take accountability and demonstrate this within their role.

As with all qualifications candidates benefit from support and where possible we would encourage all organisations to allocate a named mentor in the workplace to support the candidate with day to day concerns about study or general duties within their role.

Units/topics covered:

Candidates can undertake a number of pathways depending on their role. These routes include Dementia, Adults with Learning Disabilities and a Generic pathway.



Type of assessment:

This qualification is work based and candidates are assessed on their ability to perform a range of tasks connected with their work. Candidates plan a programme of development and assessment with their assessor and compile a portfolio of evidence to prove that they are competent and knowledgeable in their work role.

Where can it lead?

Accreditation towards further Health & Social Care qualifications and improved skills and knowledge which could lead to promotion.
