WHAT ARE COUNTY LINES?

County Lines is one of the most prevalent forms of modern slavery in the UK today & is hidden within our communities. Vulnerable people of all ages are being used by drug dealers across the country to courier drugs and money. They will often force a vulnerable person to allow them to take up residence in their home (this is known as cuckooing) to sell drugs in the local area.

What are the signs to look for?

- Has a friend or student on one of your courses gone missing for days at a time?
- Are they frequently meeting with unfamiliar people from outside the college or university?
- Is there a change in their behaviour?
- Have they acquired money or expensive gifts they can't account for?
- Have you noticed more people calling at a friend's home? Often at unsociable hours?
- Have you noticed any suspicious vehicles or people at a friend's home?
